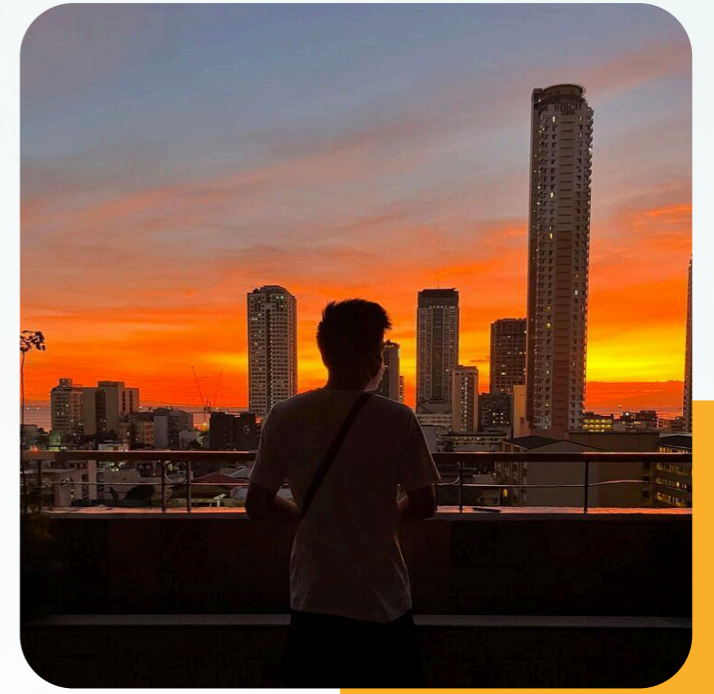


Arrival Shock: What Every Migrant Needs to Know to Thrive
